

## Hospital does well on state inspection

Warren Memorial Hospital (WMH) recently hosted a state inspection team from Nebraska Health and Human Services System (NE HHSS). After three days of review by two surveyors - only one deficiency was found in Radiology. Our policy states that aprons and other radiation shields will be inspected every six months and records showed the last inspection had been longer than that.

State Fire Marshals always inspect each time the Nursing Home or Hospital is inspected. "They found zero deficiencies that I am aware of. Formal reports from both agencies will be arriving within 10 days," explained John Wilson, the hospital's CEO. "Several recommendations were made for repairs and upgrades that we will address immediately. We could not have done this well without our professional and competent staff."
