

## Rudolph Krupicka

Rudolph (Rudy) Krupicka, 92 years and 11 months, rural Denton, passed away at the Sunrise Country Manor, rural Milford on Thursday, July 5, 2007. Rudy was born to Adolph and Vlasta (Renner) Krupicka at Milligan, Nebraska on August 2, 1914. He grew up on a farm east of Pleasant Hill. He graduated from 8th grade from Evergreen Country School District # 25 in Saline County.

Rudy loved the farm and animals, spending his whole life tending them. On September 21, 1943, Rudy and Martha Brhel were married in Wilber, Nebraska. They farmed for a short time in Saline County and then moved to the home near Denton in Lancaster County where they lived and farmed until a few months ago when Rudy's health began to fail. They have been residing at the Manor near Milford together. They had been married for 63 years last September.

Rudy was preceded in death by his parents, Adolph and Vlasta Krupicka, oldest brother, Henry, at age 6, and a brother, Edward of California
